IT IS RETREAT TIME AGAIN AT ST. GREGORY'S ABBEY IN SHAWNEE: They will host two retreats.

June 29-July 1 "Life in the Spirit" Led by Abbot Lawrence Stasyszen O.S.B. ~ Abbot Lawrence will explore the fruits of the Holy Spirit and how they might be manifested or compromised in our modern lives. Participants should bring a Bible for use in group discussions and private meditation.

July 27-29 "Our Hearts Are Restless Lord" Led by Father Charles Buckley O.S.B. ~ Father Charles will help us discover if our longings are truly directed toward God and how to respond to this subtle call of God that comes to us in our own experience. Of assistance in this reflection will be the book 'The Human Poetry of Faith': A Spiritual Guide to Life by John Paul Gallagher, S. J.

General Retreat Information: Registration begins at 6:00 p.m. on Friday evening of the retreat (June 29 or July 27) in the St. Gregory's University Residence Hall Lobby. Opening session is at 8 p.m. The retreat will end by 3 p.m. Sunday. Participants will also be welcome to participate with the monks in their common prayer and, as much as possible, in the celebration of the Eucharist. Participants will stay in private rooms and all linens are provided. Meals begin Saturday with breakfast and a sandwich tray available after the Friday evening session. Use of the swimming pool, aerobic center and visiting the museum will be open in the free time. Cost for the retreat is \$90 per person for early payment, \$95 for those who pay at registration. This fee includes lodging, meals, and registration fee. An offering is taken up for the retreat master.
