**P.I.E.** is a non-profit organization that seeks to provide youth exchange opportunities for high school students to live in the U.S., attend public high school and learn about American culture. P.I.E. is looking for volunteer host families to open their hearts and homes to foreign exchange students for the upcoming school year. Families are asked to provide a loving, caring environment, a room (which can be shared) and three meals a day. Students speak English, attend your local high school, have health insurance and bring their own spending money. Consider taking part in this unique opportunity to learn first-hand about new cultures, traditions, and languages! **CCI** volunteer host families provide the meals for the exchange student and a place to stay (a student must have his or her own bed in either a separate room or in a shared room with a host sibling of similar age and same gender). Students have their own spending money to cover personal expenses and have accident and health insurance through the program. Host families are not compensated for hosting a high school exchange student per U.S. Department of State regulations. However, families are eligible for a modest tax deduction for each month they host a student. CCI host families come in all shapes and sizes and represent the diversity of American culture. Our families are of varied economic, religious and racial backgrounds and include working parents, couples without children, singles and single parents, adoptive parents, empty nesters, in addition to the traditional nuclear family. All host families complete an application and must clear a background check.
