For the Church throughout the world, may this **Year of Faith** may be a time of spiritual renewal and personal encounter with Christ for people everywhere.

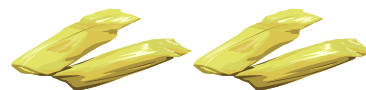
### *Marriage As Covenant – Marriage Preparation*

Too often we assume that second marriages need little or no preparation, but 60% of second marriages end in divorce. This seems to be due in part to unanticipated problems and miscommunications. "STEPPING INTO MARRIAGE WITH CHILDREN" a Marriage Preparation class will be held on Saturday, November 3, at the Catholic Pastoral Center, 7501 NW Expressway in Oklahoma City. Sign-in begins at 8:45 a.m. with the first session beginning promptly at 9a.m. The cost of the day is \$40.00 per couple. The format is varied and includes presentations by qualified individuals, who are aware of the situations in a stepfamily marriage. **CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE:** At Christmas time, foster parents are not allotted any extra money to purchase gifts for children in their care. For the last 40 years, St. Philip's has administered a program that obtains Christmas wishlists from foster children, and then distributes the wishlists to parishioners who purchase the children's gifts (within certain monetary guidelines). The program also collects money from those simply wishing to donate but not shop. St. Philip's is seeking St. Mary's participation in a variety of ways: parishioners adopting wishlists and purchasing the gifts with their own funds, monetary donations from those who want to help but not shop, help shopping with the donated funds, gift wrapping, etc. Wishlists will be distributed around Thanksgiving, and the gifts must be turned into St. Philip's by December 2nd.
