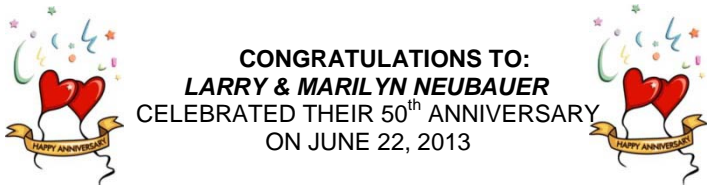
To All Parents: If your child/children are planning on attending, please complete the form and return to the tray in the vestibule of the church. **VBS will start July 29th and end August 2nd.**

St. Gregory's Abbey 2013 Summer Retreats --- Shawnee, OK

July 5-7 The Incarnation of Love – Holiness in the Rule of St. Benedict Led by Abbott L. Stasyszen, O.S.B. The Second Vatican Council emphasized that all baptized persons are called to a life of holiness. Abbot Lawrence will examine the quest for holiness in the Rule of St. Benedict. In doing so, he considers how St. Benedict brings holiness from the realm of theory and into the reality of daily life as the embodiment of love.

July 26-28 A Weekend with St. Francis de Sales Led by Fr. Charles Buckley, O.S.B. This retreat will center on the teaching of St. Francis de Sales. The goal will be to enhance the way we experience and live out our relationship with God and our neighbor within the continuum of all space and time.

Registration begins at 6:00 p.m. on Friday evening of the retreat (July 5th or 26th) in the St. Gregory's University Residence Hall Lobby. Opening session is at 8 p.m. The retreat will end by 3 p.m. Sunday. Retreatants will also be welcome to participate with the monks in prayer and in the celebration of the Eucharist. Each bathroom is shared between two rooms. All linens are provided. Meals beginning with Saturday breakfast in the monastic dining room. Participants will be able to use the swimming pool, aerobic center and museum in their free time. Cost for the retreat for those who prepay are: \$90/private room, \$75/semi-private room, and \$30/no room. The fee is an additional \$5 for those not paying until their arrival. At the end of each retreat, an offering is taken up for the retreat master. Special payment plans may be arranged.

I plan to attend the July 26-28 session and can take up to three people. Departure will be 4:15 p.m. from the St. Mary parking lot on Friday, July 26, returning after lunch on Sunday, July 28. Contact me, Charlie Tanner for information (580) 226-1507.
