Please save the date: On September 21, 2012 a Red Mass will be celebrated at the regularly scheduled 5:00 pm Mass at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Oklahoma City. Archbishop Coakley will preside. The homilist will be Bishop Weisenburger (Salina). A reception will follow in the Connor Center. In the United States, a Red Mass for judges, attorneys and government officials is traditionally celebrated to coincide with the convening of the United States Supreme Court on the first Monday in October. (The Red Mass takes its name from the red vestments worn at the Mass, symbolic of the tongues of fire that descended on the Apostles at Pentecost.) The Mass will be dedicated to seeking guidance from the Holy Spirit for all who seek justice, and offers the opportunity to reflect on what Catholics believe is the responsibility of all in the legal profession.
