Archdiocese to live stream diaconate, priesthood ordinations

This summer, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City celebrates the ordinations of eight archdiocesan seminarians – three to the transitional diaconate and five to the priesthood. At 10 a.m. Saturday, June 7, Archbishop Paul Coakley will ordain Aaron James Foshee, Daniel Gregory Grover and Lance Allan Warren to the Order of Deacon. At 10 a.m. Saturday, June 28, the archbishop will ordain Christopher Todd Brashears, Linh Ngoc Bui, Christopher De Loera, Carson Jerran Krittenbrink and Timothy Frank Ruckel to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. For the first time in the history of the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, these events will be broadcast to the public via the Internet.
