This summer, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City celebrates the ordinations of eight archdiocesan seminarians – three to the transitional diaconate and five to the priesthood. At 10 a.m. Saturday, June 28, Archbishop Paul Coakley will ordain Christopher Todd Brashears, Linh Ngoc Bui, Christopher De Loera, Carson Jerran Krittenbrink and Timothy Frank Ruckel to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. For the first time in the history of the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City, these events will be broadcast to the public via the Internet.
