## Article 3 (Standing and Special Committees)

### Section 1

The president shall appoint the chairman of each standing and special committee. Each chairman shall then elect her committee members

### Section 2

Standing committees and their duties are:

- **Spiritual Committee:** To call on those who are ill, send cards, and spiritual bouquets, and to recommend Masses.
- **Corporal Committee:** To arrange food for the relatives of a deceased person.
- **Meals for New Mothers:** To arrange a meal for new mothers in the parish after they have returned home with the baby.

## Article 4 (Meetings)

The general meetings of the organization will be held the second Wednesday of each month.

## Article 5 (Quorum)

Fifteen members shall constitute a quorum of a general meeting

## Article 6 (Termination of Office)

### Section 1

The secretary and treasurer of this organization, at the end of their terms of office, whether by resignation or annual election of offices, shall turn over their respective books and all documents immediately to the newly elected officers.

### Section 2

At any time an officer resigns, such resignation shall be submitted to the pastor in writing, stating the reason for such resignation

## Article 7

Robert's Rule of Order shall govern the deliberation of the organization and shall be enforced.

## Article 8 (Order of Business)

- 1) Call the meeting to order with a prayer
- 2) Call for the Secretary's report of the last meeting
- 3) Call for Treasurer's report

Call for a report from the chairman of each Standing Committee:

A. Social    B. Corporal    C. Meals for new Mothers

- 4) Call for report of special committees.
- 5) Call for any unfinished business.
- 6) Call for any new business.
- 7) Remarks and comments by Pastor
- 8) Program (Introduction)
- 9) Adjourn meeting and close with a prayer.

## BY-LAWS

### Article 1

#### Section 1

The president shall preside at all meetings of the organization and shall have power to call all meetings, act as an advisory member of all project committees, check regularly with standing committees, and call board meetings.

#### Section 2

The vice president shall assume all duties of the president in her absence, select monthly hostesses for the year, and be responsible for compiling the yearbook, and see that all women newcomers are invited to our regular meeting.

#### Section 3

The secretary shall keep a record of the minutes of each meeting, regular or called, conduct all correspondence, and present minutes to the club for approval.

#### Section 4

The treasurer shall be custodian of all funds of the organization, collect all dues, receive all donations, promptly pay all bills as ordered by the president, and report once a month the financial condition of the organization. The treasurer shall present an annual report

#### Section 5

The Parliamentarian shall be ready at all times to settle matters of parliamentary rules and procedures. It shall also be her duty to read the constitution and by-laws when the president deems it necessary.

#### Section 6

The historian shall be responsible for the upkeep of The Women of Saint Mary's Scrapbook.

#### Section 7

Guide lines for the selection of the Woman of the Year

1. This award is to be a singular honor and given each year.
2. That written nomination accompanied by reasons for such nomination be accepted by the officers at both meetings and at other times. A notice in the bulletin may call for nominations.
3. The criteria will be continuous and faithful service to Saint Mary's Church.
4. The award will be decided by the officers and awarded at the Spring Luncheon.

### Article 2 (Executive Board)

The Executive Board shall consist of the duly elected officers of the organization, together with the chairman of each standing committee. The board shall meet at the call of the president.

## THE WOMEN OF SAINT MARY'S CONSTITUTION

We, the Women of Saint Mary, in order to conduct our organization in an orderly manner, to promote harmony and cooperation among our members, that all of our activities may rebound to the greater glory and honor of God, and to the benefit of our Church, so hereby establish this constitution for the Women of Saint Mary, Our Lady of the Rosary Church, Ardmore, OK

### **Article 1 (Name)**

This organization shall be known as "The Women of Saint Mary" Ardmore, Oklahoma.

### **Article 2 (Object)**

#### *Section 1*

The object of our organization is to promote a great love of God and of His Blessed Mother by providing articles and supplies necessary for the Church. In addition, the club will continue to sponsor those parish functions that are traditional and those decided at the discretion of the group.

#### *Section 2*

Money collected or earned by the organization shall be used for the Church as the members of the club see fit.

### **Article 3 (Motto)**

"To Jesus- Through Mary-Behold the Handmaidens of the Lord."

### **Article 4 (Obligation)**

To attend monthly meetings regularly, to be on time, and to do one's part when called upon.

### **Article 5 (Officers)**

#### *Section 1*

The officers of the organization shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Parliamentarian, and Historian.

#### *Section 2*

Nominations for officers shall be made by a nominating committee of three members appointed by the President before the February meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor.

#### *Section 3*

The election of officers will be held at the regular meeting in March. Officers shall be elected by ballot and shall assume their duties immediately upon installation of officers at the Spring Luncheon.

#### *Section 4*

Officers will serve a term of twelve months. No officer shall hold more than one official position. No officer shall serve more than two consecutive terms. Whenever possible, the vice president will succeed the president. The out-going president automatically assumes the office of parliamentarian.

#### *Section 5*

In case of vacancy in the office of the president, the vice president will assume this office and a new vice president will be elected. If a vacancy occurs in any other office during the year, it will be filled by an election.

**CHECK LIST FOR FUNERAL DINNERS**

Tablecloths or Place Mats	Coffee & Tea

1. Contact the family to determine the number expected to attend the dinner, Inquire whether the meal will be brought to the home or be served in the Parish Hall. Knowing the time of the funeral will also be helpful.
  
2. Call parishioners for food preparations and kitchen helpers. For casseroles, ask for 9x13 foil pan. Request that all food be brought in disposable pans. Food should be scheduled to arrive at least 2 hours in advance of serving time.
  
3. Check the kitchen to see that all necessary supplies are there.
  
4. Arrive at least 2 hours in advance to heat food, complete preparations, and to receive the food as it is brought. Record on notebook who brought food for the family’s information.
  
5. Ask family if they would like to take the leftovers. If not, call the Family or Children’s Shelter.
  
6. Leave kitchen area clean and neat. Do not leave food out. Janitor will come and clean the floors and put up tables

## MONTHLY COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES:

### Chairman

#### **Pick up money bag**

Pick up a purse containing a Wal-Mart credit card and keys to the church from Joan at the church office. The credit card can be used to purchase items or food needed for a parish function supported by the women's club. Also, an allowance of \$80.00 may be used ( if needed ) to purchase flowers for the month. Please return the purse to the church office before the first of the following month.

#### **Contact committee members**

The chairman for each month should call her co-chair and committee members and discuss the things coming up for their committee during the month.

#### **Care for the church**

The monthly committee needs only to check the restroom to assure that it is clean and the trash cans are emptied.

#### **Care for the Altar**

Make sure that the Church Altar has the flowers appropriate for the occasion and that the flowers and greenery are cared for.

#### **Covered dish luncheons**

Check the paper and plastic products to assure that there will be enough to support any parish function during the month. If paper products are needed , the church pays for them, contact Joan at the church office.

Purchase the meat and make sure it gets cooked and sliced. The women's club will reimburse the expense.

#### **Flowers and care for the Altar**

Flowers and /or greenery should be checked at least twice during the week for care and water. The flower containers are in the cabinets in the Server's Sacristy. Please be sure to dispose of the old plants and flowers as soon as they appear unusable. Do not leave dead foliage in the Sacristy or in the sink.

Check altar candles and replace when necessary.

#### **Care of the Church**

The monthly committee should check the restroom after the 5:30 PM Mass and the 10:45 AM Mass to be sure it is clean. Empty the trash and diaper pail, if necessary. Items in the vestibule such as books, information pamphlets should be straightened.

#### **Refreshments for women's club meeting**

The monthly committee will provide refreshments for the monthly meeting of the women's club. Also, committee members should be available to help host and clean up after the meeting.
